## What are Cookies?

Cookies are small pieces of information that are sent and placed on an internet user's hard drive through their browser when a website is visited.

Your browser memorizes cookies on the hard drive only during the present session, besides, they only use a minimum of memory space and do not do any harm to your computer. The cookies do not contain any kind of specific personal information. The majority of cookies we use are deleted from your hard drive when your browsing session is finished (the so-called session cookies). Other cookies stay in your computer and allow us to recognize you during your next visit (the so-called permanent cookies).

When you access Google Maps, Youtube, an online shop and other types of websites, you receive cookies in your browser.

Cookies can be used to collect and store user's data while browsing the internet to provide the required services. <u>These are</u> <u>session cookies and they are not usually kept</u>. Other cookies can also be retained to collect user's data for other type of future services, these can be kept for indefinite time (persistent cookies).

There could be first-party and third-party cookies.

This website only uses technical cookies of customization and statistics, first- and third-party, which in no case deal with personal data, neither do they capture browsing preferences for advertising purposes. For this reason, when you access our website, we ask you for permission for their use, which in any case will be installed within a reasonable period of time so that the user has enough time to decide whether to give consent or not.

You can enable or disable these cookies via the configuration in your Internet browser, proceeding as follows:

### **INTERNET EXPLORER**

Select the "Tools->Internet Options" menu item, and then open the "Privacy" tab, and click on "Advanced Options".

Select the "Override automatic cookie handling" and then check the boxes "Enable" or "Block".

#### **GOOGLE CHROME**

Select the "Tools >Options", then click on the "Advanced" tab.

In the "Privacy" section click on the "Content settings" button and open the "Cookies" tab. Select the option "Allow" or "Block all the cookies".

#### **SAFARI**

Select the "Tools >Preferences", then click on the "Security" tab.

In the option "Accept cookies" select "Always" or "Never".

# **OPERA**

Select the "Tools>Preferences", then go to the "Advanced" tab.

In the "Cookies" section select the options "Accept cookies" or "Never accept cookies".
